Overview of Speech & Debate

- Regional Tournament, Saturday, March 9, 2024 at CTEC High School – typically takes place annually
- Speech Competition Components
 - Prepared speech 2 rounds time restrictions according to grade level
 - Extemporaneous speech 2 rounds time restrictions according to grade level
 - Topics released by CDE November 3
 - Rubric is the evaluation tool used that includes the following criterion: Introduction, Body, Counter Agreements, Conclusion, Originality and Creativity, Use of Language, Speaking Qualities, Eye contact, Body Language, Overall Poise, Time



Overview of Speech & Debate - cont.

Debate Competition Components

- Format is highly structured
- Teams consist of maximum of five members and no less than three
- May compete in English or Spanish, but not both
- Each round lasts 60 minutes
- Key areas of Evaluation: Content; Presentation; Adhering to debate procedures and protocol

Sharing Experience

→ Divide/Dividir

→ Share/Compartir

- -Experience debaters share first/La experiencia que los polemistas comparten primero.
- -new debaters ask questions /Los nuevos polemistas hacen preguntas.

- What benefits did you get out of this?¿Qué beneficios obtuviste con esto?




